HOME-American Rescue Plan (ARP) Allocation Plan - Substantial Amendment

PUBLIC NOTICE

Harris County Housing and Community Development (HCHCD) received an allocation of \$16,747,366 in Home Investment Partnerships Grant – American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) to help create affordable housing and services for homeless persons, people at risk of homelessness, persons fleeing domestic violence, and other vulnerable populations. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) approved the HOME ARP Allocation Plan in 2022 to expand affordable permanent supportive housing, supportive services, capacity building and operating assistance. HCHD is amending the HOME ARP Allocation Plan to include tenant-based rental assistance as a new activity and supportive services only. This amendment will include the following proposed HOME-ARP activities and budget.
