**ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS**  
**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**June 26, 2022**

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submits, in a single funding application, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. Other funding addressed includes the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) I and III, Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR), and Community Development Block Grant – Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan, and the single funding application is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 5-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendments:

**2020 ESG\_CV Funding:**

Project 2020-031m The Salvation Army of Greater Houston, CCHP- Diversion Case Management (COVID-19)(Countywide). Deobligate \$1,067,343.36 in 2020 ESG CARES Act Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$1,532,656.64.
