ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS
PUBLIC NOTICE

December 28, 2021

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submits, in a single funding application, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. Other funding addressed includes the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) I and III, Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR), and Community Development Block Grant – Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan, and the single funding application is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 5-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendments:

2020 CDBG Funding:

Project C2020-031L BakerRipley/CCHP Diversion Case Management (COVID-19)(Countywide). Deobligate \$325,000.00 in 2020 ESG CARE ACT2 Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$1,656,436.00.

Project C2020-031N BakerRipley/CCHP Rapid Re-Housing (COVID-19)(Countywide). Deobligate \$770,000.00 in 2020 ESG CARE ACT2 Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$2,888,507.00.

Project C2020-031O Career and Recovery Resources, Inc./CCHP Rapid Re-Housing (COVID-19)(Countywide). Obligate \$1,095,000.00 in 2020 ESG CARE ACT2 Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$1,495,000.00.
