

**HARRIS COUNTY COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT
ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS
PUBLIC NOTICE**

August 8, 2014

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submit, in a single application for funding, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan and the single application for funding is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 30-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendments:

2013 and 2014 HOME funding:

Project C2014-0038 Woodland Christian Towers, Inc.: Woodland Christian Tower Rehabilitation – Obligate \$1,341,689 in 2013 and 2014 HOME Funds. The project will include the rehabilitation of a 127-unit apartment building for the elderly located at 600 E. Tidwell Road, Houston TX 77022. The project activities include renovations to the existing site and structures, conversion of 72 units to Permanent Supportive Housing units, and establishing a ground-floor health clinic and counseling center.

2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 CDBG funding:

Project C2014-0039 Harris County Precinct Two: SWEA Gardens Water Improvements – Obligate \$389,818.95 in 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 CDBG Funds. The project will include the installation of water lines, master water meter, backflow preventer, and hydro-pneumatic tank. The project will provide a reliable and permanent water supply to project area residents.
