ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS
PUBLIC NOTICE

November 4, 2016

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submits, in a single application for funding, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. Other funding addressed includes Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) I and III and Community Development Block Grant – Disaster (CDBG-D) funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan, and the single application for funding is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 30-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendment:

2016 CDBG Funding:

Project C2016-0029 Harris County Precinct 3 (Parks Dept.) – Zube Park Phase 2 (Precinct 3) – *Scope Revision* – Additional activities integrated into the current project scope are as follows: weir overflow and outfall control structure, biking trails, trash cans, trees and turf establishment, expansion of three parking lots, lighting for the expanded North and East parking lots, security fencing, and general site work that includes grading, drainage and underground infrastructure for proper park drainage. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, remains unchanged at \$1,000,130.00.

2015 CDBG Funding:

Project C2015-0031 Sunbelt Fresh Water Supply District - Oakwilde Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Pkg. 7 (Precinct 2) - Deobligate \$156,310.06 in 2015 CDBG Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$368,213.75.
