Harris County Community Services Department ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS PUBLIC NOTICE

April 2, 2018

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submits, in a single application for funding, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. Other funding addressed includes Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) I and III and Community Development Block Grant – Disaster (CDBG-D) funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan, and the single application for funding is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 30-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendments:

2018 CDBG-PS Funding:

Project C2018-0005 Alliance of Community Assistance Ministries (ACAM) – Collaborative Employment Services Project (Precinct's 3 & 4) – Deobligate \$50,000.00 in 2018 CDBG-PS funds and cancel project.

Project C2018-0034 Sarah's House – Shelter Services (Countywide) – Obligate \$25,000.00 in 2018 CDBG-PS funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$50,000.00.

Project C2018-0035 Coalition for the Homeless Houston/Harris County – Rapid Re-Housing Case Management Intermediary (Countywide) – Obligate \$100,000.00 in 2017 CDBG-PS funds. *Scope Change* – Revised Scope: In addition to the Current Scope Coalition for the Homeless Houston/Harris County will add a second activity and provide emergency shelter operations and services at Harmony House for medically fragile individuals due to needs created by Hurricane Harvey and use the CDBG-PS cap waiver available to Harris County from HUD. Total project funding including previously awarded amounts, will be \$166,334.00.

2018 ESG Funding:

Project C2018-0031f Sarah's House – Shelter Services (Countywide) – Deobligate \$25,000.00 in 2018 ESG funds and cancel ESG funded activity.
