ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS
PUBLIC NOTICE

June 17, 2016

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submits, in a single application for funding, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. Other funding addressed includes Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) I and III and Community Development Block Grant – Disaster (CDBG-D) funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan, and the single application for funding is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 30-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendment:

2015 CDBG Funding:

C2015-0011 Harris County Protective Services - TRIAD Prevention Program: Truancy Learning Camps (Countywide) - Deobligate \$12,493.82 in 2015 CDBG Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$31,506.18.

2014 CDBG Funding:

Project 2014-0027 Harris County Community Services Department – Health & Safety Home Repair Program (Countywide) - Deobligate \$133,591.55 in 2014 CDBG Funds. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$26,408.45.

2014 and 2012 CDBG Funding:

Project C2016-0036 Harris County Community Services Department - Oates Road Cemetery Drainage Improvements (Countywide) – *New Project*: Obligate \$14,896.27 in 2012 CDBG Funds and obligate \$35,103.73 in 2014 CDBG Funds for design and drainage improvements at the Oates Road Cemetery for indigent burials located at 5434 Oates Road, Houston, TX 77013. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, will be \$50,000.00.
