Community Meeting to Discuss 2016 Flood Recovery and CDBG-DR Infrastructure Funding

On April 17 to 30, 2016 and May 22, 2016 to June 24, 2016, Harris County sustained significant damage from two major flooding events that resulted from severe storms and flooding. As a result, both flooding events were Presidentially Declared as Disasters in Harris County. U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has allocated the State of Texas Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-DR) funding for 2016 disaster recovery. The Texas General Land Office (GLO) is the CDBG-DR administrator of the State's allocation. The amount allocated to Harris County by the GLO is \$19,044,584 for infrastructure projects.
