ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS
PUBLIC NOTICE

June 10, 2019

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submits, in a single application for funding, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. Other funding addressed includes the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) I and III and Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan, and the single application for funding is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 30-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendments:

2018 ESG Funding:

Project C2018-0041 Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) – Homelessness Prevention (Countywide) – *New Project*: Obligate \$111,497.51 in 2018 ESG funds. HCCSD Office of Social Services will provide homelessness prevention services including housing stabilization and short/medium term rental assistance to 60 eligible households. Total Harris County project funding will be \$111,497.51.
