# Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Partnerships, and Emergency Solutions Grants Programs

## Public Notice November 14, 2016

The Harris County Annual Action Plan (AAP) is the one-year planning document, which describes the amount of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) funds expected to be available and the proposed use of those funds for the upcoming program year. Because Harris County's normal AAP submission deadline falls before the date the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) announces FY2017 allocation amounts for CDBG, ESG and HOME, the AAP will be submitted no more than 60 days after the date HUD announces FY2017 allocation amounts. Prior to submission, the public is allowed to review and comment on the AAP's proposed use of funds.

This notice is provided to inform the public of availability of the Program Year 2017 (PY2017) AAP and provide information about projects recommended for funding during PY2017. The amount of funds expected to be available in PY2017 (March 1, 2017 to February 28, 2018) is based upon funds allocated to Harris County by HUD in PY2016. Actual funding amounts for PY2017 are not likely to be released before December 2016; therefore, Harris County may be required to reduce, increase or de-obligate funding to the recommended project allocations should the actual allocation change from the PY2016 amounts.
